Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regattas will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Laser class rules Rule 7 (a) is deleted and replaced by:
The Laser shall be raced by one person onboard. The crew shall not change during the event.
- 1.3. The YNZ Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. Notwithstanding the dispensation granted by Yachting New Zealand, sailboard competitors shall comply with clause 1.
- 1.4. Rule 61.1(a) will be modified so that Optimist and P Class yachts will not be exempt from displaying a protest flag.
- 1.5. Add to rule A11: ARB means scoring penalty after arbitration, PTS scoring penalty for a yellow flag after finish.
- 1.6. Advertising - The organising authority may require competing boats to carry event sponsor advertising on the hull.

2. FORMAT

- 2.1. Winter Championships is a three day regatta (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) for junior and youth classes including Optimist Green, Optimist Open, P Class, Starling Green, Starling, Splash, Laser 4.7 Sunburst, 420 and Techno board. It is also a three day regatta for the Laser class.
- 2.2. Winter Championships is a two day regatta for senior classes including Laser Radial, 470, RSX, Hobie etc. Social, non scoring racing for these classes will be available on Friday on the course being used by the Lasers. The Laser class will have priority on this course as this regatta is a World Championship qualifying regatta for the Lasers.
- 2.3. For Winter Championships entries for a minimum of 6 boats per class is required for a separate fleet to be sailed.
- 2.4. Entries for the NZ Girls Secondary Schools Regatta will be accepted from boats in the Optimist, P Class, Starling, Splash, Laser 4.7, Sunburst and 420 class boats.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1. The entry fees are detailed on the attached schedule.

3.2. To be eligible to compete in this event each competitor shall be a member of a club or other organisation affiliated to the National Authority.

4. ENTRY CLOSING DATE

4.1. Entries will be accepted up to 0830 on the first day of sailing of each class.

4.2. All entries for the Winter Championships that are received and paid for before Tuesday 18th September will receive a good quality regatta sports bag.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The Auckland Centreboard Clubs Standard Sailing Instruction will apply and are available on www.murraysbay.org.

6. VENUE

6.1. Racing will take place on the waters off Murrays Bay Beach

7. MEASUREMENT

7.1. All boats must comply with their class rules at all times during the regatta.

7.2. Wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the Regatta at the discretion of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.

9. IMMEDIATE PENALTIES FOR BREAKING RULE 42

9.1. Appendix P will apply with the following changes:

9.2. For the Optimist, P Class Starling, Splash and Laser 4.7 classes' rules P2.2 and P2.3 are deleted and rule P2.1 will apply to all protests.

9.3. For all other classes rule P2.3 will not apply and rule P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any protest after the first one.

9.4. Action taken by the Protest Committee under Appendix P will not be grounds for redress by a competitor.

10. ALTERNATIVE PENALTIES

10.1. For protests where only a rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken, an arbitration hearing may be offered prior to any formal protest hearing.

11. SCORING

11.1. The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

11.2. 2 races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.

11.3. For the Secondary School Girls Regatta the Catherine Tizard Cup will be awarded to the winning team. To win the Catherine Tizard Cup a school must be a member of College Sport and must have three boats one of which shall be a Sunburst or 420. The score for a boat, other than a sunburst or 420, shall only count for the Catherine Tizard Cup if that boat is sailing in a fleet with 5 or more entries in that fleet. To assess team points fleet points will be equalised.

12. WHISTLE SYSTEM

12.1. To encourage boats to take penalties afloat, Protest Committee members may blow a whistle when they see what they believe to be a breach of a rule.

13. SAFETY

13.1. Competitors shall wear a life jacket or other adequate personal buoyancy at all times when afloat.

13.2. Wet suits and dry suits do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy.

14. LAUNCHING RESTRICTIONS

14.1. All boats will be required to launch and retrieve from Murrays Bay Beach except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

14.2. Senior classes may launch and retrieve from Mairangi Bay Beach.

15. SUPPORT BOATS

15.1. The movements of support boats will be restricted

16. COACHING

16.1. A coaching program for all junior classes will be organised by Murrays Bay Sailing Club on Monday 24th and Tuesday 25th of September. Registration and payment for this coaching shall be received by Tuesday 18th September.
